#### A. Requirements for Graduation.....minimum 60 units

- 1. Complete 60 degree-applicable units (courses numbered 50 and above), not to include more than 4 units of physical activity.
- 2. Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in all degree-applicable units including all units from other colleges attended if applicable.
- 3. Complete at least 12 units at Victor Valley College.

VVC may not accept credits from all institutions of higher education.

To transfer to a university for a Bachelor's Degree, choose courses for your Associate's Degree that simultaneously satisfy your university's lower division requirements. To transfer to the University of California (UC) or to the California State University (CSU), you will most likely want to complete the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or, for CSU only, the General Education Requirements for Transfer Certification (CSUGE), as part of your Associate's Degree. Visit the Transfer Center and <a href="https://www.assist.org">www.assist.org</a> for more information about preparing for transfer. Also, ask about the "Associate Degree for Transfer."
