

ENROLLMENT PROCESS (For Spring 2013 ONLY)

After the prerequisites have been verified and there are still too many qualified applicants for the spaces available, the following steps will be followed for admission into the VVC Nursing Program.

1. Completion of all non-nursing courses applicable to the Associate Degree in Science, Nursing Major (with the exception of Non-graduate and 30-Unit Option Applicants).
2. Completion of 24 or more units at VVCC and/or Barstow Community College. These units must be from the prerequisite sciences and/or the general education courses as listed (excluding the Biology and Chemistry prerequisites to Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology).
3. Two or less withdrawals or incompletes (W or I) of the completed prerequisite courses (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology).

School will notify students that meet the above criteria of the TEAS testing date, time, and location.*

*If there are more than 65 that meet all the criteria (1-3 above), a random draw will be conducted to determine which applicants move forward for TEAS testing.

4. Testing of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
Successful passing of composite score ($\geq 62\%$) on the Testing of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS V) exam. (Basic Math, English, Reading, and Science)**
5. Random draw of applicants that successfully passed the TEAS at Step 4, for starting date or wait list.

**Applicants who do not pass the TEAS will be required to remediate and demonstrate readiness before entering the program. Remediation may include, but is not limited to, successful completion of additional coursework, tutoring, or retesting. The remediation may take one year. Readiness is accomplished by successfully passing the TEAS V examination.

*****COUNSELING AVAILABLE*****

Please note that VVC's Nursing Program is very popular and typically has a waiting list for qualified applicants.
