

INTERSEGMENTAL GENERAL EDUCATION (GE) TRANSFER CURRICULUM (IGETC)

OBJECTIVE: Completion of all the requirements in the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) permits a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University or the University of California system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses to satisfy university's general education requirements.

EXCEPTIONS: All campuses will accept IGETC except UC Berkeley's Haas School of Business and UC San Diego's Roosevelt and Revelle Colleges. Also, IGETC is not recommended for science, engineering, or other high unit majors at most campuses. These students should follow the general education pattern of the specific campus they plan to attend. Visit assist.org for more information.

CERTIFICATION: All areas of the IGETC should be certified prior to transfer. Partial certification may be awarded if all but two (2) courses in any areas except Group 1 and 2 are completed. Students are responsible for requesting IGETC certification by completing the "Request for Certification of Transfer General Education Requirements" form available in Counseling.

Each course must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.
