July 26– August 29	<b>Block 3C</b> Priority registration for Continuing Students with 15 - 29.5 units completed at VVC
July 28 – August 29	<b>Block 3D</b> Priority registration for Continuing Students with 0 - 14.5 units completed at VVC <i>*See fee payment information below</i>
August 2 – August 29	<b>Block 4</b> Registration for New/Returning Students who have completed assessment and advisement/orientation by <b>July 28</b> and students with more than 90 units completed at VVC
August 3 – August 29	<b>Block 5</b> Registration for all other students (New/Transfer)
August 5 - August 29	<b>Block 6</b> Registration for concurrently enrolled K-12 students
