May 28 - June 20	Block 3D Priority registration for Continuing Students with 0 - 14.5 units completed at VVC <i>*See fee payment information below</i>
May 31	Memorial Day Holiday (no classes, offices closed, no registration services)
June 1 - June 20	Block 4 Registration for New/Returning Students who have completed assessment and advisement/orientation by <u>May 28</u> and students with more than 90 units completed at VVC <i>*See fee payment information below</i>
June 3 - June 20	Block 5 Registration for all other students (New/Transfer) <i>*See fee payment information below</i>
June 4	Last day parking permits will be mailed. After this date, parking permits must be picked up at the Bursar's Office.

June 30	Last day to drop an 8-week class without receiving a "W"
