



AP 5410 Associated Students Elections

The Associated Students shall conduct annual elections to elect officers.

- Student elections for the Associated Student Body are conducted within the last 4 weeks of the spring semester or as stated in a ratified constitution of the Associated Student Body.

Any student elected as an officer of the Associated Students Body shall meet the requirements in BP 5410 Associated Students Elections as well as those stated in the Associated Student Body of Victor Valley College ratified constitution.

- Unit and grade point average (GPA) requirements are strictly followed. To maintain office, the student must complete six units per semester and have a cumulative GPA of 2.0.

The term of office for ASB Council officers shall be one (1) school year; ending on the last day of regularly scheduled spring classes, with the next year's council beginning the day after.

A student may serve on the ASB Council no more than six (6) total semesters, including no more than four semesters four (4) as an executive officer unless appointed under special circumstances.

The governing documents for the Associated Students Body, including Elections, are the ASB Constitution and Bylaws.
