Basic Life Support (BLS) Provider Certification

Prospective EMT students are required to have, and keep active, basic life support provider status throughout the EMT program. If your card does not state "BLS Provider," it will not be accepted. Acceptable certification institutions include the American Heart Association, American Red Cross, and the Military Training Network.
