








5. Page components – Bottom half. For full page view of dashboard, select "click here."




6. Full screen view of dashboard for Course Disproportionate Impact (DI) Reporting Tool. Once selection is made, click on "Go to Summary."




7. Using PSYC-101 as a sample, below are the key components of the Summary page.






