PREREQUISITES

Completion of Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology with a grade of “C” or better within the last 5 years.* All science prerequisites and general education courses, which apply to the VVC Nursing Degree, must be completed at time of submission of application. CLEP scores are not accepted to satisfy prerequisites. Successful completion of the TEAS V examination or higher version of TEAS, within two (2) attempts maximum. (=>62% for TEAS) Students will be notified of TEAS testing dates within the application period.

(NOTE: All courses, including prerequisites, must be completed with “C” or better. A grade of “C-” is not accepted.)
