



## 2022-2023 VERIFICATION WORKSHEET DEPENDENT/INDEPENDENT STUDENT

Federal verification is a process which requires institutions to verify the accuracy of the information provided on a student's FAFSA in an effort to ensure federal aid is distributed to those who are eligible. **Your FAFSA is selected for verification by the U.S. Department of Education.** You are required to provide documentation to the school verifying the information you entered on your FAFSA. Reasons for being selected for verification include: your FAFSA contains estimated information or inconsistencies, was incomplete, or was selected at random. If there is a difference between your FAFSA and documentation submitted, the college will make the correction electronically.

**\* Victor Valley College reserves the right to request additional documentation as needed to complete this process or resolve conflicting information.**

Once you complete and sign this document, upload your forms directly to the financial aid self-service portion of WebAdvisor by clicking on "complete required documents". Incomplete, unreadable or missing documents will delay processing and awarding of financial aid. **The Office of Financial Aid is a paperless office and accepts documents via WebAdvisor. Emailed or faxed documents will not be accepted. Our office is happy to assist you in person with scanning your documents.**
