RESOLUTION CONDEMNING ADMINISTRATION'S FAILURE TO MAINTAIN CAMPUS FACILITIES

Whereas, The Academic Senate has received countless reports of poorly maintained classrooms, meeting rooms, bathrooms, buildings and facilities used by students over the last three years; these reports include but are not limited to: lack of heating, lack of air conditioning, dangerous temperatures for physical labor in CTE facilities, lack of running water, little to no access to water and bathroom facilities, and

Whereas, the Academic Senate recognizes the critical importance of well-maintained facilities to ensuring students, staff and faculty can function in a safe environment in accordance with federal, state and local health & safety standards; and

Whereas, the campus does not receive communication regarding the activities and/or status of maintaining facilities and communication relating to occupational health and safety is critical to students, staff and faculty being able to function; be it THEREFORE resolved

RESOLVED the Academic Senate urges the President / Superintendent and Executive Team to take immediate action on all facility concerns; *and be it further*

RESOLVED the Academic Senate requests the President / Superintendent develop a Plan of Action to respond to facility concerns in timely and substantive ways to ensure the health and safety of all campus constituents.
