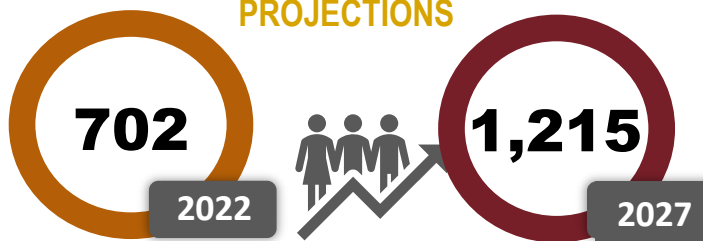

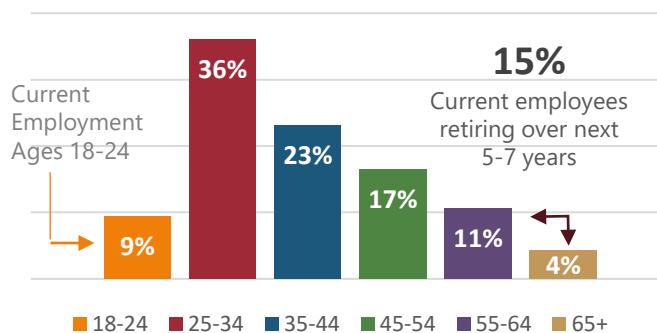


EMPLOYMENT PROJECTIONS

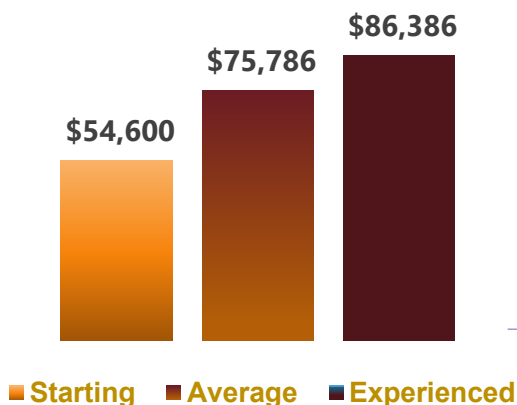
