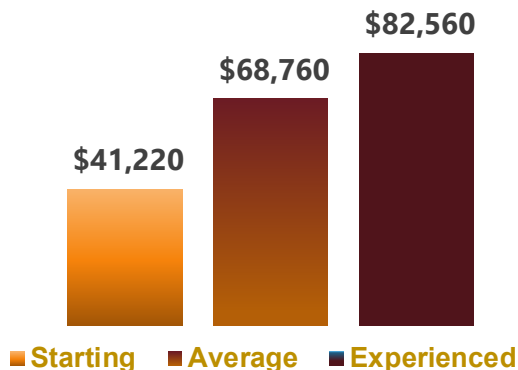

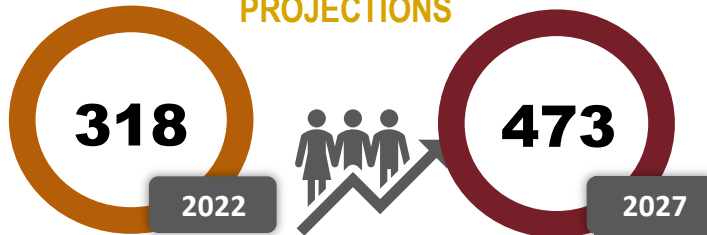


**Salary Guide**

AVERAGE BY EXPERIENCE

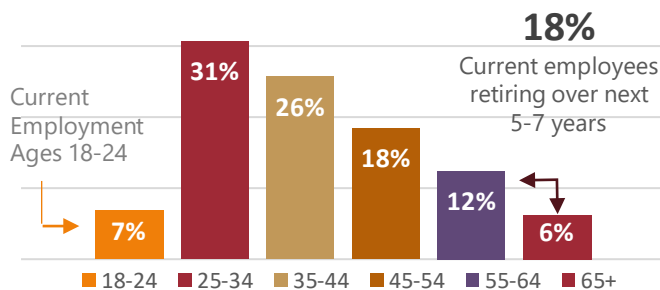


**EMPLOYMENT PROJECTIONS**

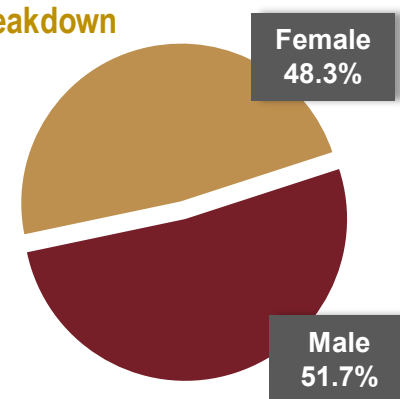
