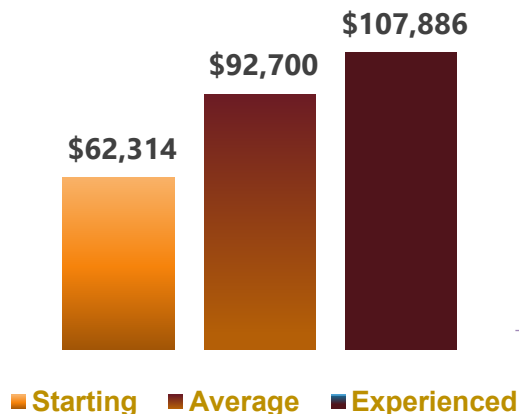

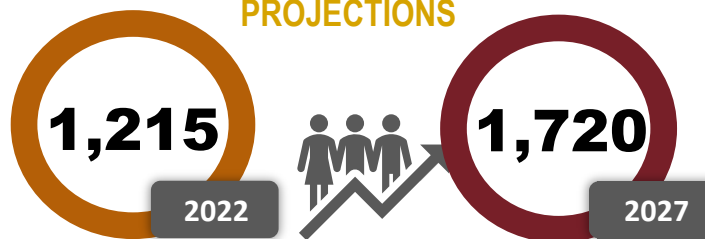

AVERAGE BY EXPERIENCE

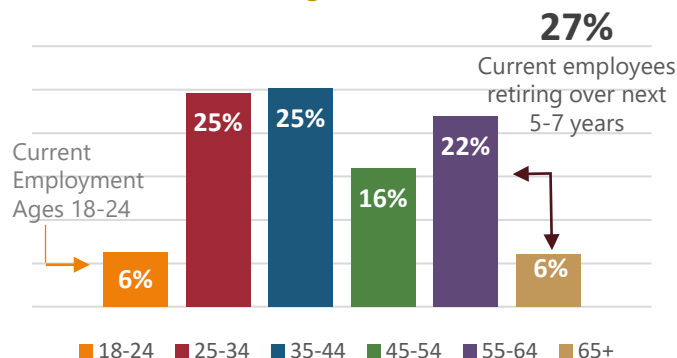


## EMPLOYMENT PROJECTIONS
