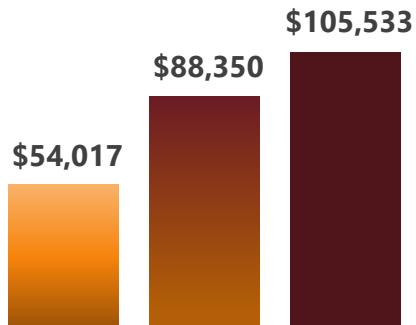

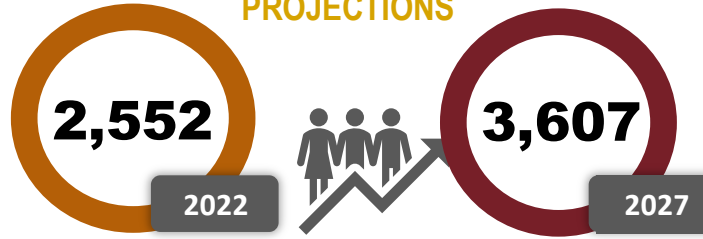

AVERAGE BY EXPERIENCE



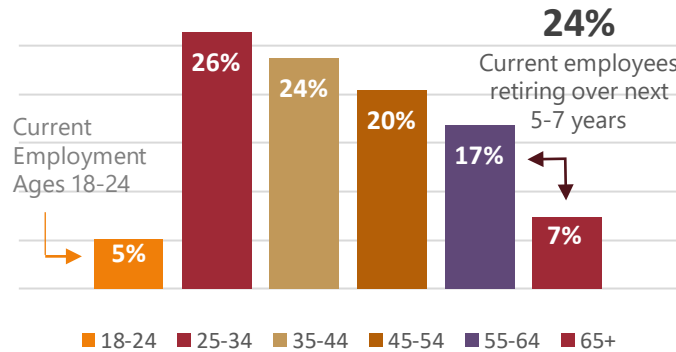

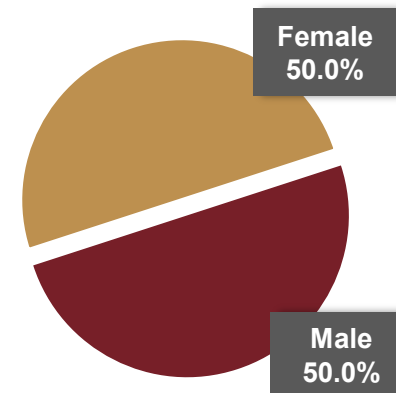
