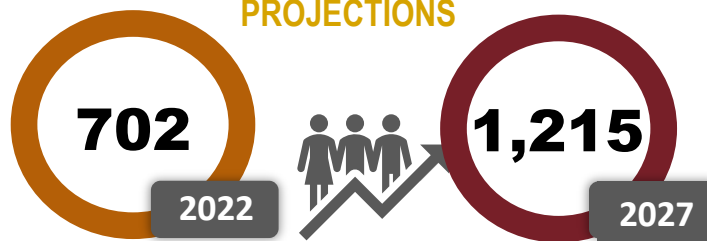

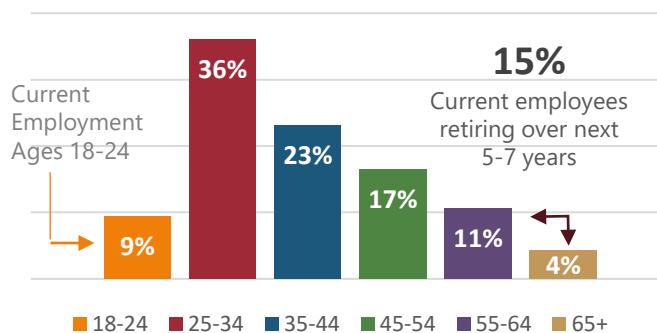


## EMPLOYMENT PROJECTIONS

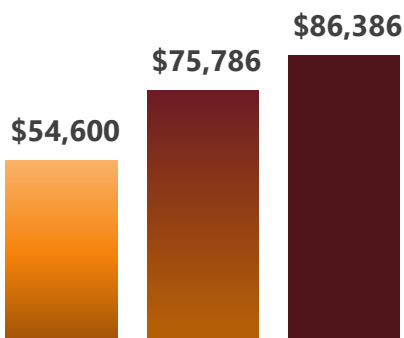
