Students can apply for a state permit if they have work experience in this career field. Verification of experience is not required for the certificate issued by Victor Valley College.

To be eligible for the Child Development state permit (Associate Teacher), students must have 50 days of work experience, which can include unpaid volunteer experience, within the past 2 years. A day of experience is equal to a minimum of three hours and is not cumulative. For example, if a student works less than three hours, then the day does not count. If the student works more than 3 hours on a single day, then the student is credited for one day (regardless of the number of hours worked). To verify work experience, students can select option A or B.

Option A (for students working in the field)

Complete a Verification of Experience Form. This form must be submitted with the Permit Application. Contact Heather Hammond-Williams, in the Child Development office, via email at heather.williams@vvc.edu for assistance.

Option B (for students with no work experience in the field)




