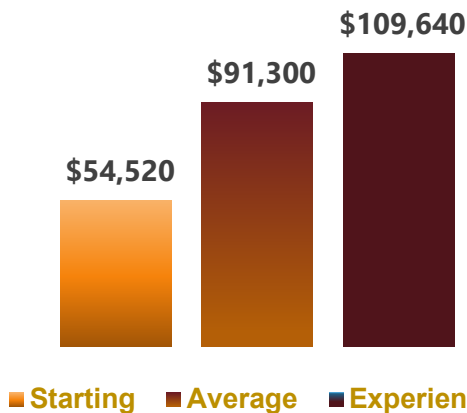

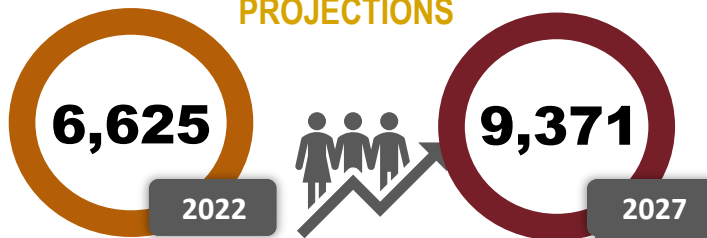

AVERAGE BY EXPERIENCE

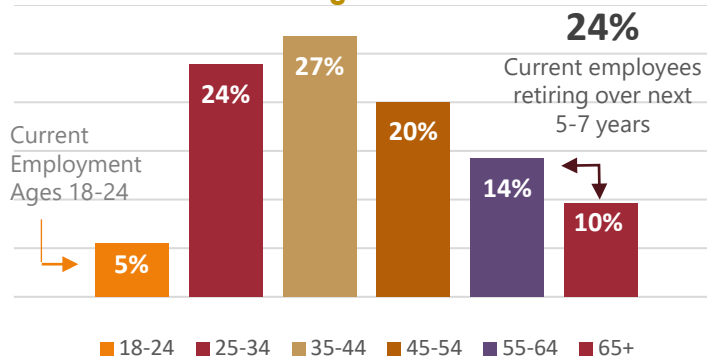


**EMPLOYMENT PROJECTIONS**

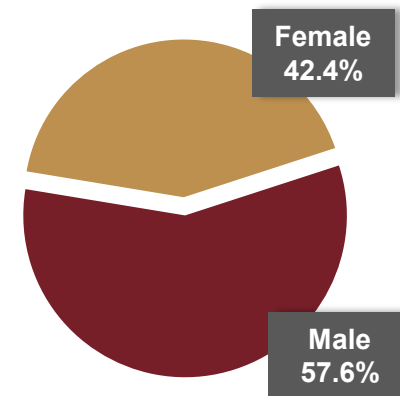
