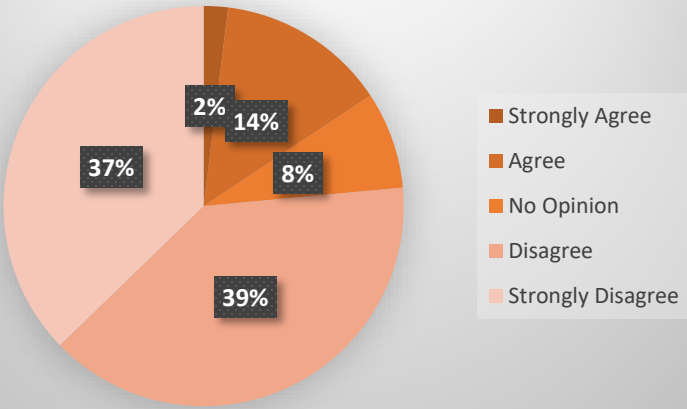
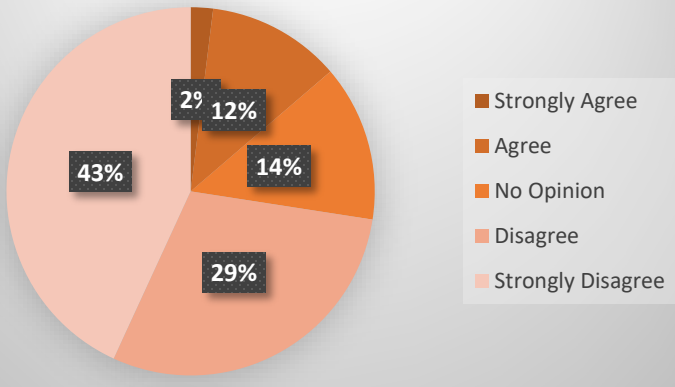

Other Priorities Faculty Noted:

- Timely and relevant training on campus processes, use of Canvas, and use of technology.
- Advocate to hire more Counselors in General Counseling and or Student Success Coaches to assist the Counseling Dept. Almost same number of counselors the last 20 yrs and student population has increased significantly. Also many have retired/ left and positions not filled.
- remove this disgusting excuse of an administration.
- Advocate discussion on use of AI (Artificial Intelligence) and use of AI Writing Detection for use in evaluating student writing.
- CTE Supply Budgets. We have had the same budget for 12 years despite enrollment growth and inflation. We are now getting supplemental Lottery Funds, but these are on a case-by-case basis, so it's hard to plan and complicated to administer. Our budgets should grow with inflation and change with enrollment over time. It creates extra work for the Dean's Office, and a lot of uncertainty for the departments --- not to mention the extra coordination of tracking POs that are created/submitted by other people, rather than out of your own department.
- 1. Recommend having an "All College Hour" for several hours each week. This could be a time for committee meetings, faculty PD workshops, and student club meetings. 2. Before instructors are assigned to classes, there should be a conversation between deans, dept. chairs, and full-time faculty wherein faculty can review and give recommendations. BLAR instructors are being assigned arbitrarily at the dean's discretion, to the detriment of students, VVC, and other faculty.
- Hire a proficient IT/ software company or bring back our old IT guys who knew what they were doing.

- The options above focus on the failures of this administration, I'm not sure what we can do about them, this administration has no respect for faculty and does not value working collegially with faculty. They simply don't care, is the feeling I have, and this is the worst it's been in the 20+ years I have been here.

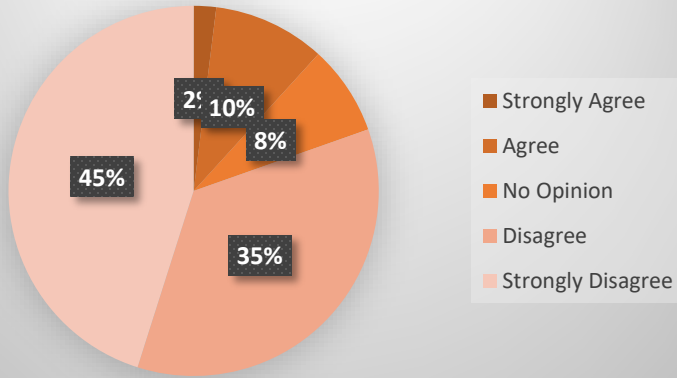

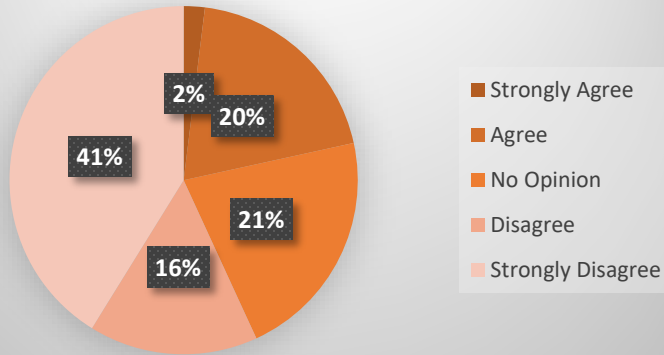
