§ 55062 - Bachelor's Degree and General Education for Associate Degrees

Per § 55062, students who have been awarded a bachelor's degree from an institutionally accredited institution are considered to have fulfilled the general education requirements for an associate degree.

Victor Valley College (VVC) Policy: VVC will recognize any accredited bachelor's degree that meets our transfer and accreditation standards and will waive all general education requirements and competencies for our local associate degrees. (Does not include international transcripts)

Students with Baccalaureate Degrees

Those students who have been awarded a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in the United States will be exempt from the Victor Valley College general education breadth requirements and the proficiency competency requirements, should they pursue an associate degree at this institution. Official transcripts from the degree granting institution must be submitted to the Admissions & Records Office for evaluation.
