There are multiple pieces of equipment that we send out for repair including welding machines, oxy-acetylene welding and cutting torches, regulators, track cutters, plasma cutters, grinders, and other various small shop equipment. On average every time we send out a piece of welding equipment with a large failure it costs around \$1500-\$2000 dollars. So we can only send out 1 piece of equipment a year as we have other repair needs around the shop. We also have a backlog of equipment that needs repair. The cost of having some of this equipment repaired increases its useful and safe life at a cost significantly lower than a replacement cost.
