Advisor Sewell stated to double check the students information, and not to have long conversations especially when the line is long — doing ID's is networking. Mentor Isbell stated that being flexible is necessary such as having to change meeting rooms on a short notice. For those who researched names for September 11th he thanked them as it's important to learn about the names. Committees can only have 9 council members, he suggested to keep them small. He stated that he knows it is hard to vote publicly but that it is necessary. He is excited that the council wants to put the Student Handbooks out but recommended they not go to the Hesperia campus or Regional Public Safety Center. He suggested flyers with a web address or QR code should be made available at those campuses instead. Hall of Fame happens in the Spring semester and nominations for inductees are due in 3 weeks - council traditionally has a recommendation. Council can recommend people for nominations.
