Admission Requirements

Associate of Science in Respiratory Therapy (AS-RT) degree required

Applicants must hold or be completing an AS-RT degree from a CoARC-accredited program. If currently enrolled in an AS-RT program, you must graduate by the start of the summer term.

No minimum GPA requirement.

Lower division general education courses may be completed concurrently with BSRT coursework.
