- Mentor Isbell:
 - The restrooms in building 60 and building 80 are being fixed, they are currently closed. They poured concrete ramps that now meet ADA guidelines - the old ramps did not. Also new ramps for portable classrooms of building 66. He stated to start preparing yourself for the DC trip as you will be speaking with elected officials and other colleges. He will be assigning everyone their DC presentations that are required and not optional. Be prepared in classes if you plan to travel. He mentioned to be careful when doing ID's, accurate ID information is incredibly important. Nursing and EMT students have specific ID's so they need to be 100% accurate. Their uniforms are necessary for their ID's. Make sure to choose recommenders for the letters of recommendations for scholarship applications and be prepared. Halfway through winter classes. He stated there are only 4 weeks before spring semester starts. He updated his three challenges to three plus one: daily affirmations, genuinely appreciating someone else, accept it when you are appreciated, and if you are walking within 10 feet of someone else acknowledge them with a hello or a good morning, etc. SSCCC GA - he stated if he didn't suggest you for the trip it isn't personal. It has to do with the budget, and the involvement. He asked if the council is interested in alumni coming to present about the DC trip.
