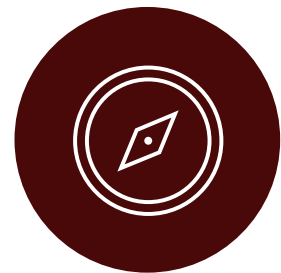

FTEs growth over the past four years



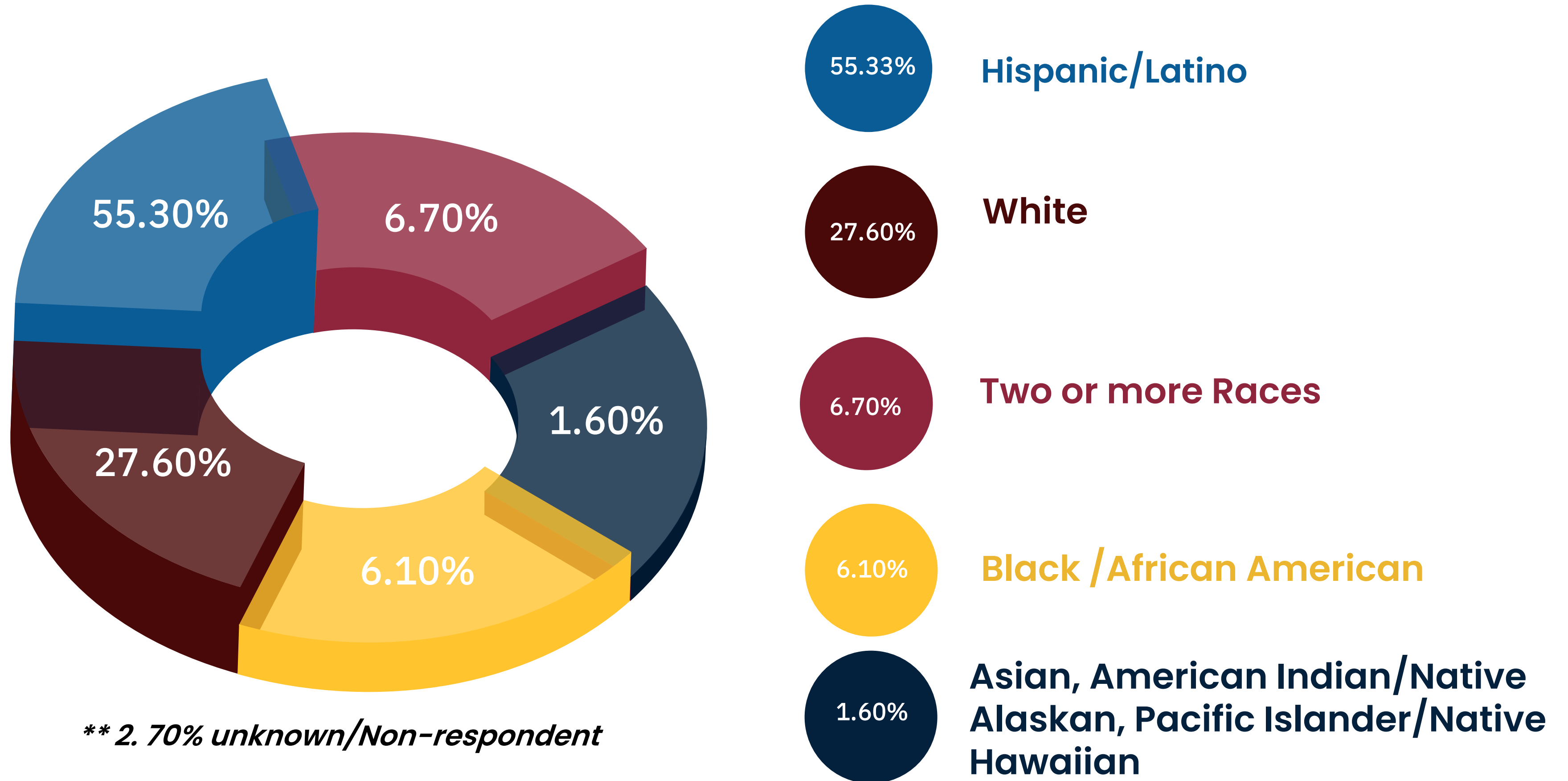

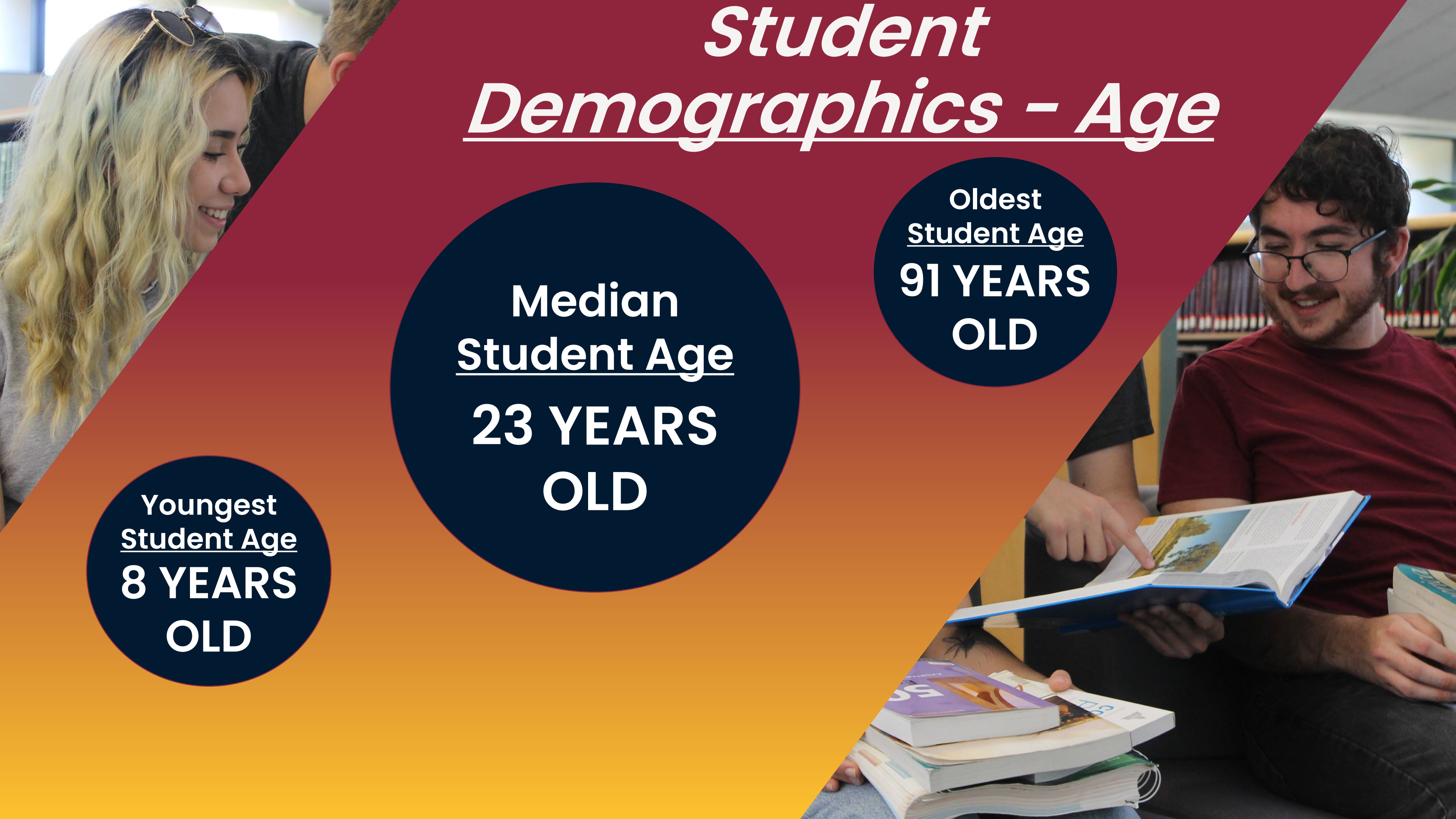
Student Headcount over the past four years

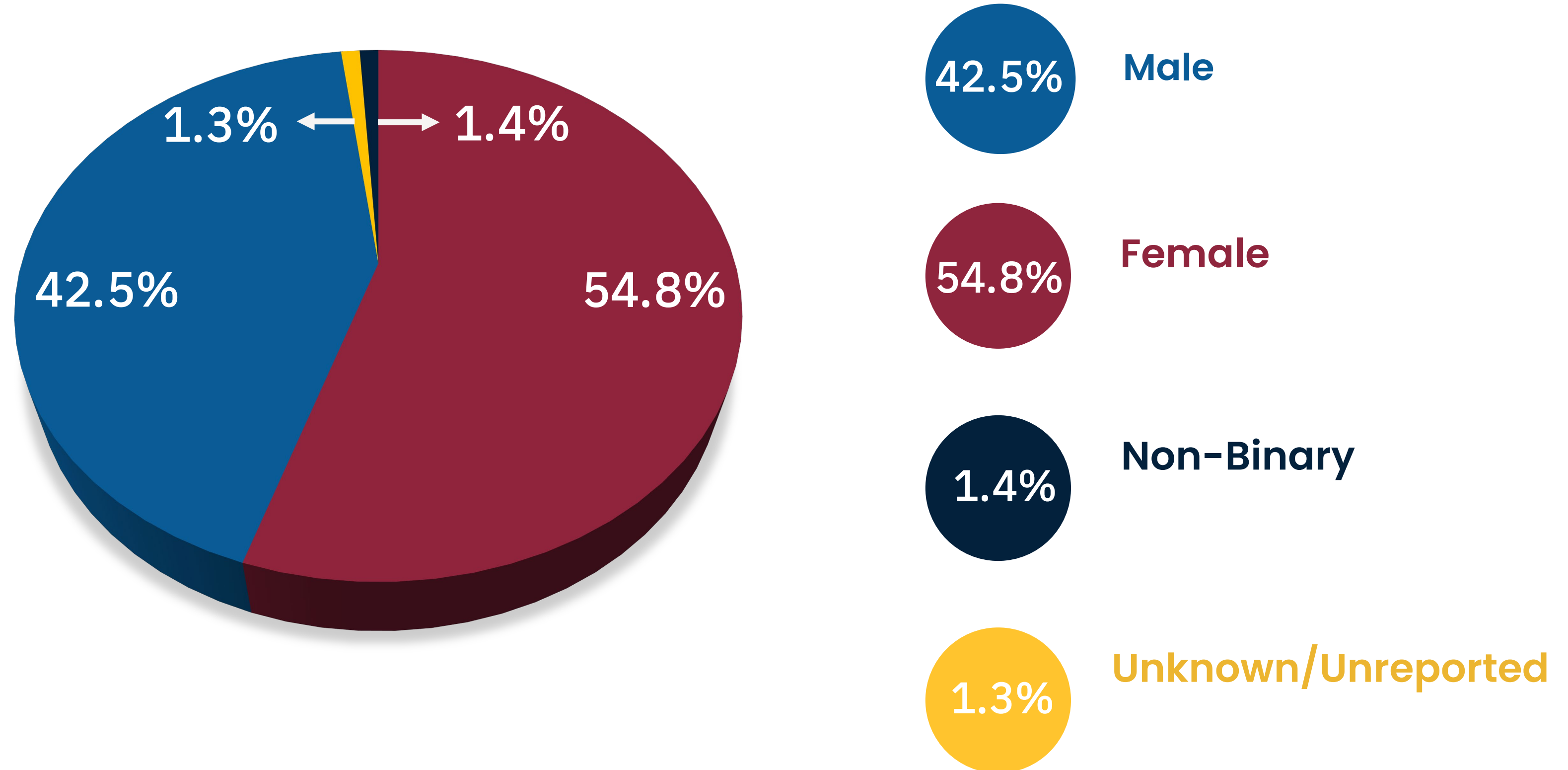

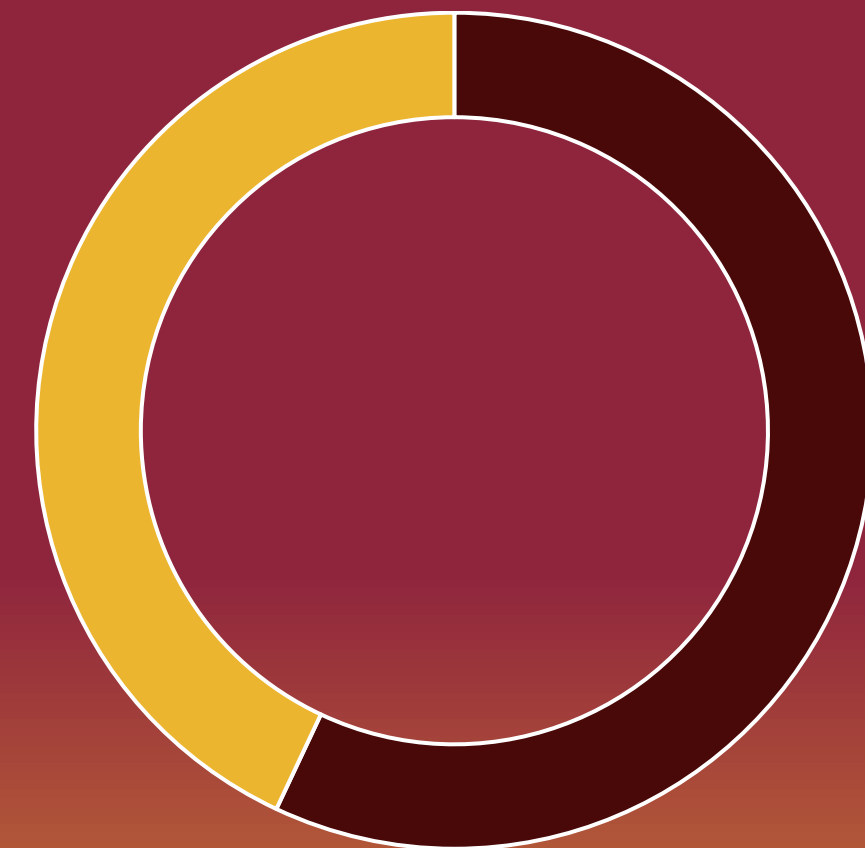

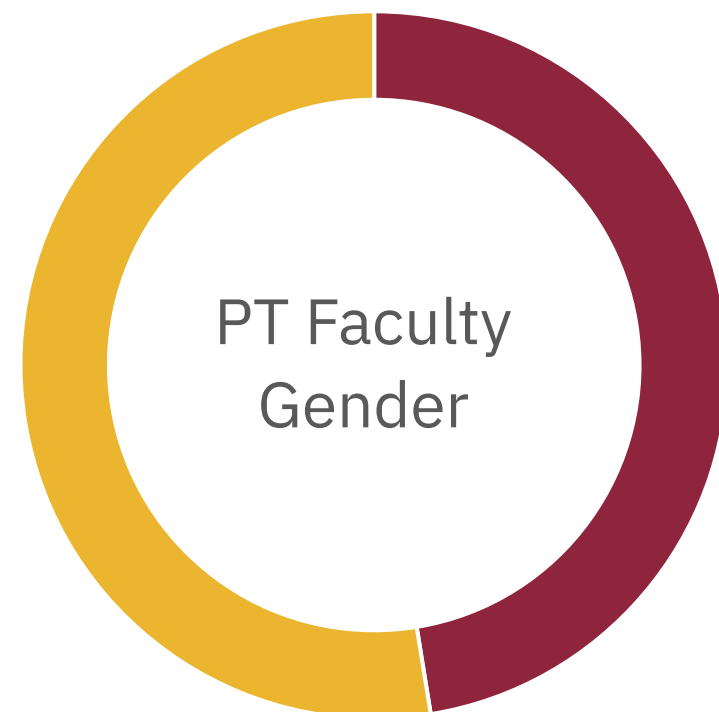

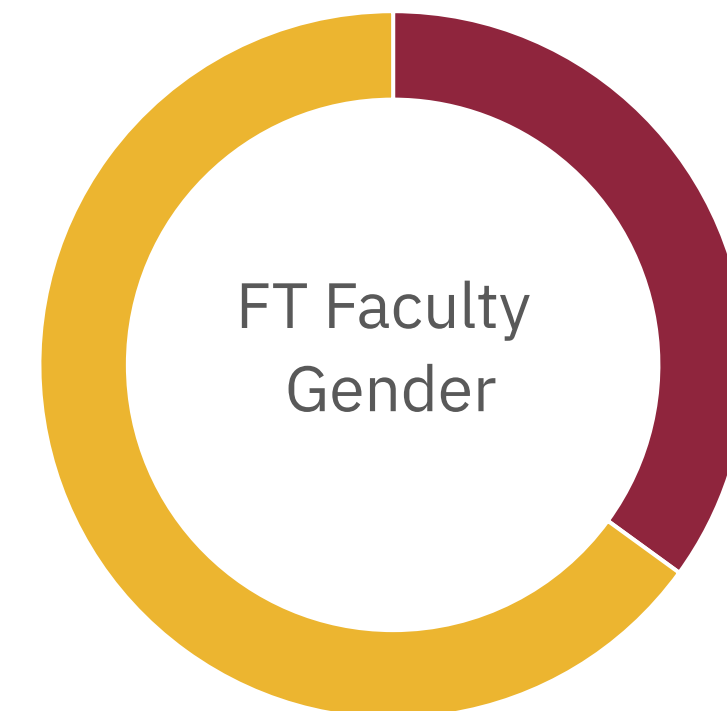

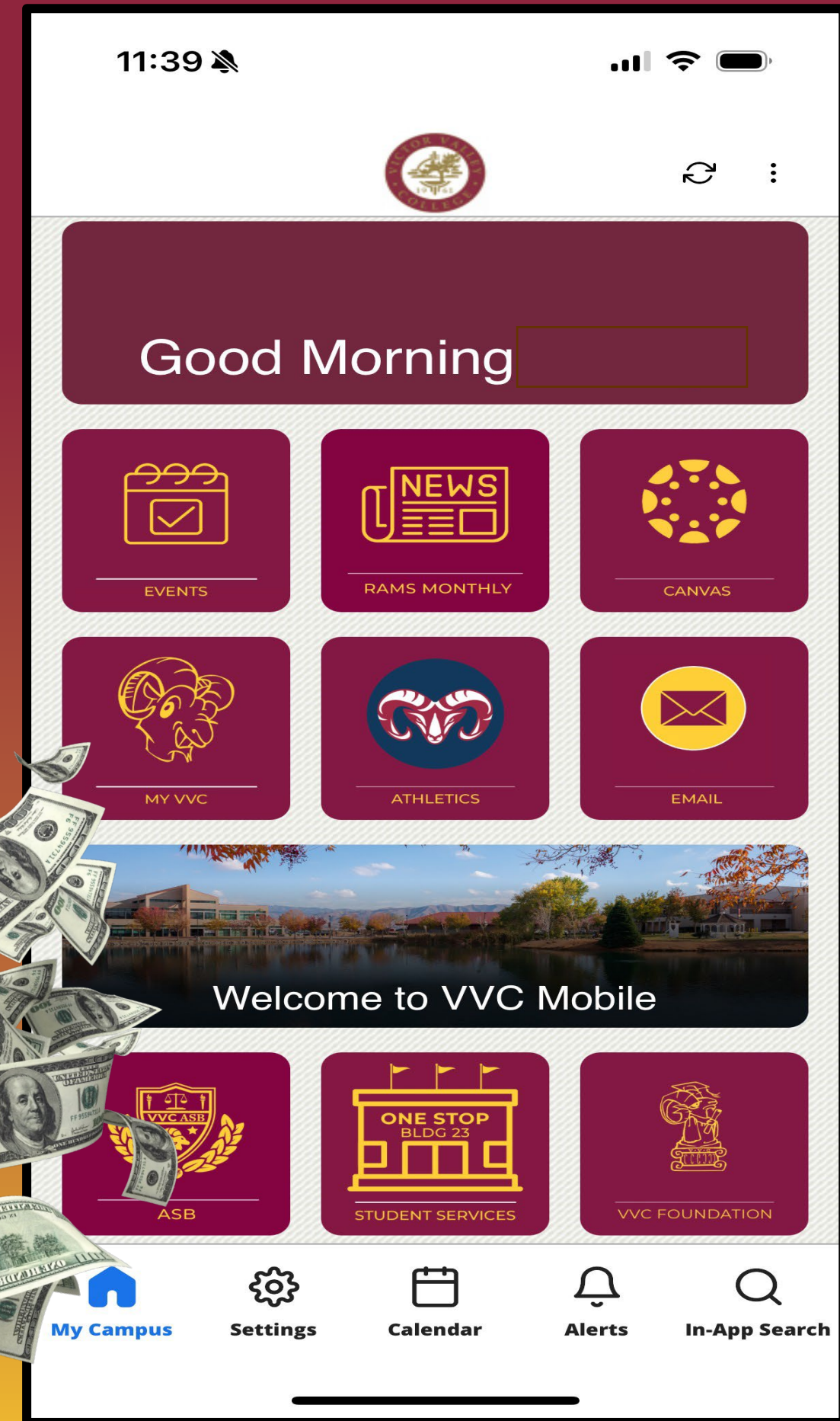
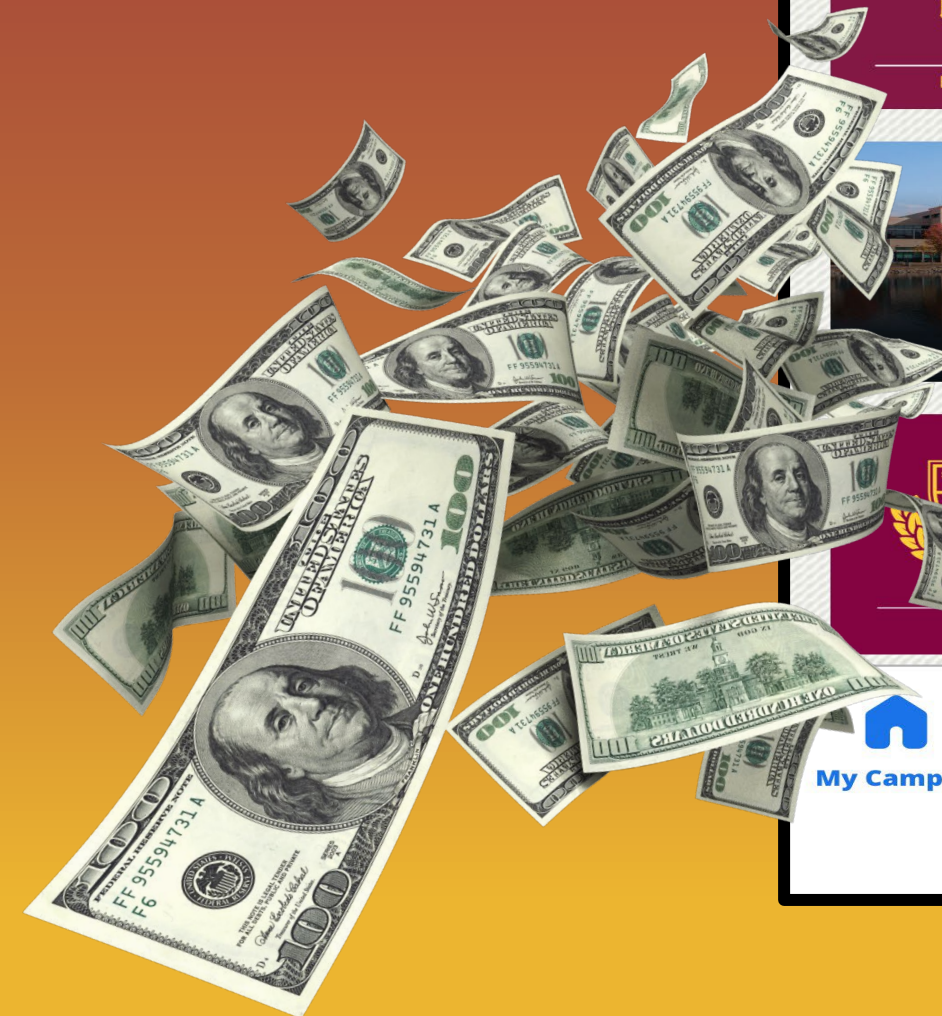
- *Through the VVC Mobil App, students will earn points by attending events held on campus*

First Electric Vehicle for our CDL Program

- California Clean Fleet requires to be 50% with zero emission by 2027
- Due to VVC's investment in Solar Energy, these trucks will significantly lower operating costs, as the trucks will be charged with solar power we generate

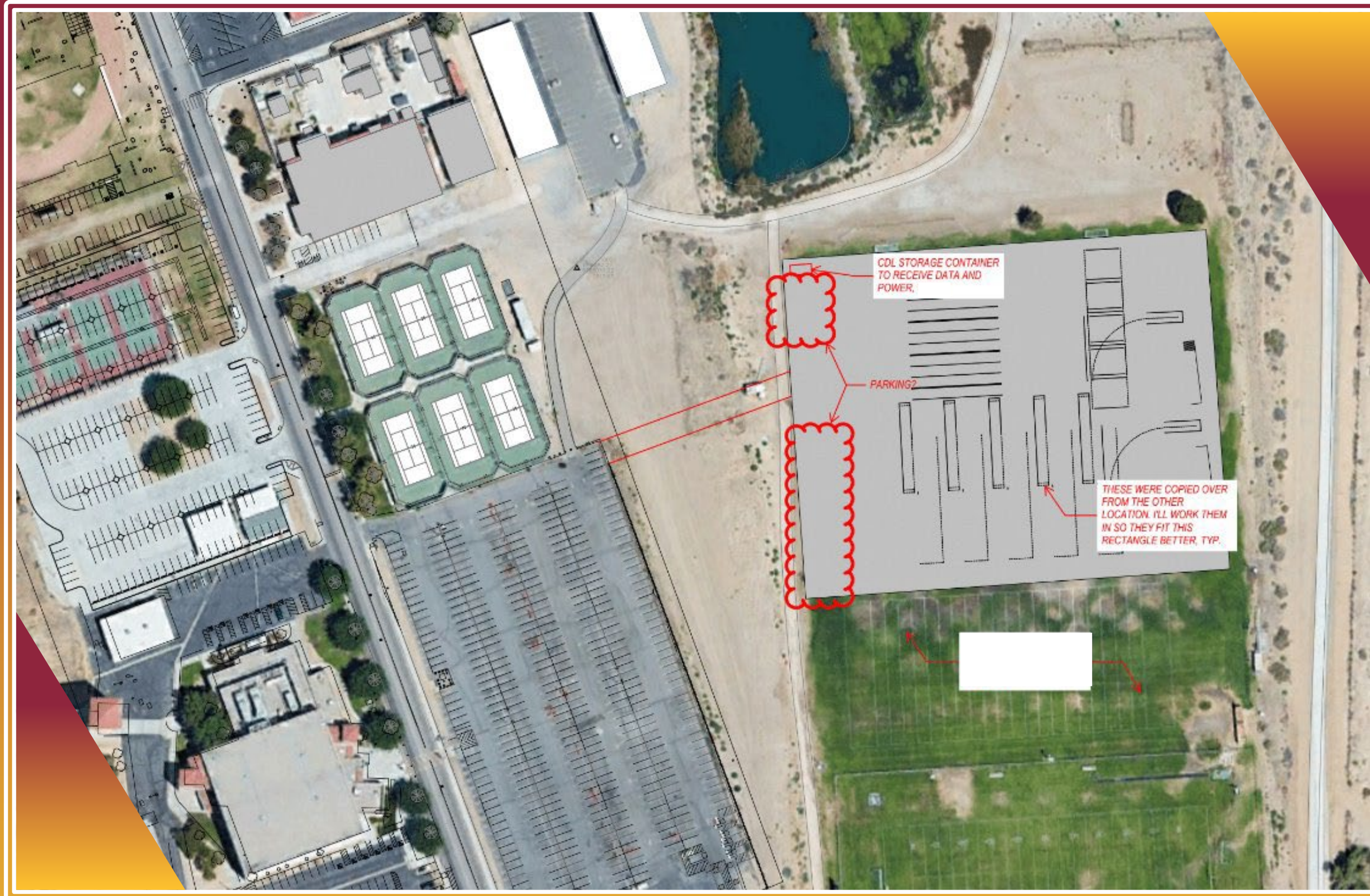

- **Health fee agreed upon by students: \$24 for Fall and Spring and \$17 for Winter and Summer**
- **The Center will provide:**

 - **Health Insurance Assistance**
 - **Referral Services**
 - **Specialty Clinics**

ASU Partnership with VVC for Online Bachelor's Program

- *Victor Valley College is partnering with Arizona State University to help students earn their bachelor's degree fully online*
- *Through this partnership, eligible students can:*
 - *Save on Tuition with \$130 in savings per credit hour*
 - *Seamlessly transfer after earning their associate's degree*
 - *Choose from 250+ undergraduate programs that fit their goals*
 - *Take all classes online*
 - *Start on one of six enrollment dates each year*
