



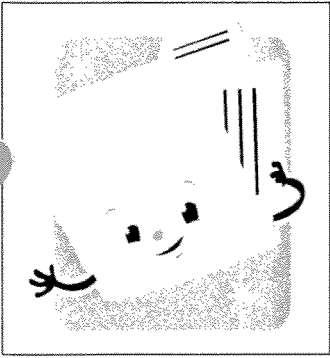

1) Approval of the Minutes

A. **June 16, 2010** ~ Approved by consensus

2) August Board Agenda Review

Dr. O'Hearn reviewed and discussed the agenda for interpretation and approval.

3) Accreditation

Dr. O'Hearn reported that the Co-chairs met again, all is on track, progress is being made, and the rough draft for the first standard is completed; very pleased with the self-study at this point. The accrediting commission will be visiting the campus in March 2011.

4) One-Stop

Dr. O'Hearn reported that during last month's board meeting, direction was given from the board to go ahead with the One-Stop. The One-Stop will connect the upper and lower campus; project is to follow the Master plan written in 2005 (Five Year Plan). The time duration for the project is unknown, could possibly take a few years to implement and complete. The monies to build the One-Stop will come from the bond.
