- DESCRIPTION:** This course presents information and skill development to students seeking employment and a career with a wildland fire agency. This course provides 80 hours of wildland firefighter training. Upon completion, students will receive National Wildland Coordinating Group (NWCG) certification in I-100, S-110, S-130, S-190 and L-180. Students must have a good attitude and a willingness to work hard.

- PREREQUISITE:** None -- For Employment with the Federal Fire Agencies you will also need to complete Fire 61B, Fire 66, and Fire 82A before, during or after completion of Fire 59. For CalFire Basic Certification you will need to complete Fire 95(Firefighter I Academy) or California Firefighter I Training at an Accredited Academy AND Fire 59B.
